In September 2014, St Nicholas Catholic High School will be opening a provision for students with Autism Spectrum Condition (ASC). As a fully inclusive school, we already have students with ASC who are part of our community and so this provision is simply an extension of what we already do.

In preparation for this change, and after listening to some of the wishes of our ASC students, we would like to deliver a programme of ASC education across the school. This programme would consist of a form time session where students would learn a little bit about what ASC is. It will develop the understanding of the students, and hopefully promote tolerance and acceptance. Often students do not know why certain students behave in a particular way, and once they can see the reason behind the behaviour, they can react to it in a more suitable way.
