# School/Home Partnership Agreement

In partnership, the School and Home will each seek to support the development of each student. As a part of this joint commitment the School declares its intention to:

- provide a Catholic education suited to the student's age, ability and aptitude, and encourage a full and active part in all aspects of school life;
- provide parents/carers with regular information regarding progress, achievements, attendance and punctuality, alerting parents to any concerns or problems the school has;
- set, mark and record homework according to the published Homework Timetable for each student;
- keep parents/carers informed about school activities through regular correspondence;
- provide a student diary which will lay out expectations for students and parents;
- expect the student to keep to the Code of Conduct;
- regularly use the Student Diary as an important means of communication with parents/carers;
- provide, on request, copies of particular school policies not published in the school website.

As part of this joint commitment the Parent/Carer declare their intentions to:

- encourage the students to make the most of his/her abilities and the opportunities offered by this Catholic School;
- ensure good attendance and punctuality in support of the School Attendance Policy, informing School immediately of any difficulties, and will attend the school as appropriate;
- support the School Homework Policy and provide the best possible conditions at home for its pursuit and completion;
- support the school in insisting the student adheres to the 'Code of Conduct';
- attend Parents' Evening and other discussions as necessary;
- recognise the importance of the Student Diary as a source of information about School policies and procedures and a means of communication. Accordingly, parents/carers regularly refer to, use, inspect and sign the Diary;
- support the School's policies as published in the Student Diary and elsewhere and will seek further information about policy and procedure if/when in doubt.
